Death Breakdown
The 3 puppies that died all had parvo virus and were undergoing extensive treatment for the illness when they passed.
One cat that died had feline leukemia disease and got ill. She was being treated for the illness but the feline leukemia caused her to be unable to fight of the disease.
One cat had FIP and concurrent liver disease that were being treated at time of death.
The 3rd kitten that died was only 3 weeks old and had a severe repirsatory infection that was being treated at time of death.

Euthansia Breakdown
The one dog that was euthanised was undergoing treatment for parvo. Despite extensive treatment the puppy showed no signs of improvement and eventually lapsed into a coma.
