#### **Death Breakdown**

1 Puppy that died was in hypovolemic shock when came to APA due to parasites and also was possibly septic. Puppy died immediately after intake while being examined.

3 Puppies were being treated for parvo but did not survive treatment

1 Puppy was being treated for parvo and distemper but did not survive.

1 dog came to APA with a bowel obstruction as well as intecescption that had been going on for days. Emergency surgery was performed as well as blood transfusion and hospitalization but he died that night after 2 days of care. Was probably septic.

1 puppy came to apa after ingesting rat poison, died at intake before treatments could be administered.

2 pups were neonates only a couple of weeks old and died of Fading Puppy Syndrome

2 puppies were neonates that had severe anatomical deformities and died shortly after intake

The last 3 puppies that died were all stillborn (deceased at birth)

#### **Euthansia Breakdown**

The 1 dog euthanasia was a puppy being treated for parvo and distemper that was unresponsive to treatment and suffering
