

## MISSION STATEMENT

To provide the resources, education, and programs needed to eliminate the killing of companion animals.

## LIFESAVING PROGRAMS

- **Barn Cat Program:** A non-traditional adoption service for cats unable to enter a traditional home.
- **Behavior Trauma and Rehabilitation Program:** Training and rehabilitation for dogs who have experienced significant trauma.
- Feline Leukemia Adoption Center A safe harbor for cats who have been diagnosed with the feline leukemia virus (FelV+).
- Maddie's® Cat Adoption Center: Treatment and Care for Ringworm Positive Cats: A dedicated treatment and education center for cats traditionally at risk of euthanasia.
- Medical Triage and Wellness Clinic: Serves as an emergency room, wellness hospital, and spay/neuter clinic.
- **Neonatal Kitten Nursery:** Committed to saving, especially fragile, homeless animals—orphaned, unweaned kittens.
- **Parvo Puppy ICU:** The first of its kind in the nation, the Parvo Puppy ICU provides care and rehabilitation to puppies who contract parvovirus and would be killed in other shelters.
- **Positive Alternatives to Shelter Surrender:** Resources and services to Texas residents who are experiencing challenges in keeping their pets.
- National Pet Transport Program Provides transport to move pets out of under-resourced shelters in Texas.

## IMPACT

Austin Pets Alive! led the movement that made Austin the largest No Kill city in the country. APA! is on a mission to permanently transform the way communities treat at-risk pets. In doing so, we can eliminate killing in shelters.
