

## Monthly Report on License Agreements 2022 - 06 June

This report is in agreement with the terms outlined in Section 8.4 of the License Agreement between the City of Austin and Austin Pets Alive! with a focus on APA!'s impact on Travis county through our partnership with Austin Animal Center.

Summary: Austin Pets Alive! (APA!) continues to be the city of Austin's largest partner in lifesaving. APA! takes animals that have medical and behavioral issues that require a higher cost per animal than the average healthy animal in care. APA! focuses on these animals in an effort to have a measurable effect on the live release rate at AAC.

#### **APA! Intakes transferred from AAC:**

389 animals were transferred out of AAC to rescue partners in June. 162 of those were transferred to APA!, and another 52 were born in care at APA! to pregnant animals sent from AAC. Additionally, APA! took in 41 pets directly from owners within Travis county through the PASS program that would otherwise have entered AAC.
