Aug 16, '08 EXAM (VET EXAM 0)

Wt: 28.5 Lb Temp: 102.7 F

*S: Dog has several large open wounds. One on the hock joint of left leg, and another higher up on left hind leg
O: QAR. Abrasions to head on muzzle and above left eye. MM pink, moist. CRT<2s. Dog can stand. Has abrasion over left shoulder. Has a lot of bruising to left side caudal abdomen and flank. There is a large abrasion to lateral left stifle with a puncture type wound adjacent. The caudal aspect of left hock is degloved and muscle is exposed. Dog was able to stand and bear weight on all 4 limbs. Worried about possible internal injuries.*

A: trauma possible HBC

P: Gave 3cc pen inj sq. Gave 50mg tramadol po. Clipped and cleaned wounds. Wrapped wound to left hock.

Aug 17, '08 TREATMENT (TX BID)

Clavamox po.

Medication: 0.75 tablet CLAVAMOX250 twice per day for 10 days from 8/17/2008 thru 8/26/2008.

Aug 17, '08 TREATMENT (TX BID)

Tramadol po

Medication: 1.00 tablet TRAMADOL twice per day for 3 days from 8/17/2008 thru 8/19/2008.

Aug 17, '08 TREATMENT (TX SID-AM)

Dr. JEY

Have dvm change bandage over left hock.

Medication: AS DIRECTED once on 8/17/2008.

MAS

S/O on dvm attn to change bandage on left hock; abrasion with dried skin over proximal L stifle, open wound over caudal L hock

A open wounds

P 10 minute hydrotherapy on both wounds, replaced L hock bandage

RX: 10 minute hydro and bandage change with neosporin and non stick dressing sid x 4 d

Aug 18, '08 TREATMENT (TX SID-AM)

MAS

RX: 10 minute hydro and bandage change with neosporin and non stick dressing sid x 4 d

Medication: 10.00 minute HYDROTHERAPY once per day for 4 days from 8/18/2008 thru 8/21/2008.

Medication: AS DIRECTED once per day for 4.00 days from 8/18/2008 thru 8/21/2008.
